The following items are required by all candidates. Individuals currently located at organizations where access to CIF is limited will be given an opportunity to draw gear from the CLNC CIF upon reporting.

**TOBACCO:** WHILE ATTENDNING A&S NO MORE THAN 2 OF ANY COMBINATION. IE: 1 PACK CIGARETTES, 1 CAN DIP; 2 PACK CIGARETTES OR 2 CANS OF DIP.

- 1. All candidates will be issued 1 mountain rucksack for use during A&S.
- 2. Cell Phone, pagers and IPODs OR any other media devices are authorized for use while attending Phase 1, use is unauthorized during training. Prior to the start of A&S cell phones, pagers and IPODs or any other media devices will be turned into the A&S staff and secured during the conduct of A&S. Items will be returned to candidates upon completion of A&S.
- 3. Students will sign for gear (common to all) during the conduct of Phase 1/A&S. Gear that is lost or damaged will be replaced by the individual prior to departure from the Marine Special Operations School.
