**I. INTRODUCTION**

The position is located in the Communication Section (S-6), Marine Special Operations School (MSOS), U.S. Marine Corps Forces, Special Operations Command (MARSOC), at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. The mission of MARSOC is to train, organize, equip, and when directed by the Commander, U.S. Special Operations Command (USSOCOM) to deploy task organized, scalable, and responsive U.S. Marine Corps special operations forces worldwide in support of combatant commanders and other agencies. MARSOC is one of four components of USSOCOM. The Commander, MARSOC is a U.S. Marine Corps Major General (O-8) and reports to the Commander, USSOCOM (O-10). In this capacity, the Commander exercises command over a force of approximately 3,200 active duty personnel from the U.S. Marine Corps, U.S. Navy, U.S. Army, U.S. Air Force and more than 200 federal civilian employees.

The C4 Training Manager reports to the Command, Control, Communications and Computers Section within MARSOC, MSOS. The primary purpose of position is to oversee the real time development of Special Operations Forces-unique (SOF-unique) and organic tactical data communications and networking capabilities to include technical training, standards, and evaluations in both classroom and field environments.

This position coordinates and interfaces with HQMC, MARSOC staff, and subordinate command counterparts, as well as Training and Education Command (TECOM), Marine Corps Combat Service Support (MCCSSS), and Marine Corps Communication Electronics School (MCCES). The incumbent will develop, maintain, task organize, and provide training standards to address C4 pre-deployment and career progression training requirements.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS**

1. This position is designated NONCRITICAL SENSITIVE and requires the incumbent to obtain and maintain a SECRET security clearance.
2. The incumbent may be required to work other than normal duty hours, which may include evenings, weekends, and/or holidays. Periodic travel will not exceed 10%. Periodic travel and work in a field environment is required.
3. The incumbent will be required to attend and obtain the following graduate certificates: Microsoft Certified Solution Associate, Certified Cisco Network Associate, SOFTACS Planners Course, Lean Six Sigma Yellow belt, Curriculum Developers Course, Harris Radio Certifications, and ITIL Foundations within the first year of employment if not already qualified in these areas/skills.
