Student must always have on their person during field training:

☐ (1) Boonie cover, MARPAT/ACUs OCP, service issued boots, service T-shirt, underwear/PT Shorts and socks (recommended wool/smart wool).
(1) LBE/LBV or equivalent, (Pouches to carry equipment)
☐ (2) Water carrying devices w/ carriers
☐ (1) Canteen Cup
☐ (1) First Aid Kit
(1) Survival Kit (Provided)
☐ (1) Fire starting device (Provided)
☐ (1) Signaling device (Signaling Mirror or Camouflage paint kit w/mirror)
☐ (1) Bottle iodine tablets or equivalent (Provided)
