

MARFORSOC PR/SERE REQUIRED GEAR LIST



Student must always have on their person during field training:

- □ (1) Boonie cover, MARPAT/ACUs OCP, service issued boots, service T-shirt, underwear/PT Shorts and socks (recommended wool/smart wool).
- (1) LBE/LBV or equivalent, (Pouches to carry equipment)
- \Box (2) Water carrying devices w/ carriers
- □ (1) Canteen Cup
- □ (1) First Aid Kit
- □ (1) Survival Kit (**Provided**)
- \Box (1) Fire starting device (**Provided**)
- □ (1) Signaling device (Signaling Mirror or Camouflage paint kit w/mirror)
- □ (1) Bottle iodine tablets or equivalent (**Provided**)
- (1) Whistle (**Provided**)
- □ (1) Watch (wrist compass or watch compass recommended)
- □ (1) Fixed blade knife (**Provided**, personal is authorized)
- □ (1) Multi-tool
- □ (1) Camouflage paint kit
- □ (1) Pair eye protection with CLEAR LENSES only (Not optional)
- □ (1) Pair gloves (Leather, Nomex Flight gloves, or Mechanix)
- \Box (1) Notetaking Gear
- \Box (1) Package of map pens and (1) protractor
- \Box (1) Headlamp w/red lens or (1) Flashlight w/ red lens
- □ (1) Prescription glasses

Required field gear (in your pack):

- □ (1) Mountain Ruck/ ALICE pack or equivalent
- □ (1) 550 cord (Min 50 ft / max 100 ft)
- □ (1) MARPAT/ACUs OCP
- □ (7) Pair socks (recommended Wool/Smart Wool)
- (2) T-shirts
- \Box (2) Pair underwear
- \Box (1) Camel Back (Third carrying device)
- ☐ (1) pair of service issued (**not optional**), (Students must have a minimum of **two pairs** of boots. The second pair can be neutral colored nonstandard OVER the ankle)
- \Box (1) E-Tool with cover
- □ (1) Poncho Liner
- \Box (1) Issued Digital Poncho or Tarp
- \Box (1) Gore-Tex top
- (1) summer sleeping bag with Gore-Tex Bivvy Shell (Poncho Liner/Ranger roll will suffice)
- □ (1) USMC Kit bag/Sea bag/ or Service equivalent (see photos on the last page)
- \Box (1) addition set of Prescription glasses
- □ Waterproof bags (Issued, off the shelf, trash bags enough to waterproof gear)

Hygiene Kit (Required):

- \Box (1) Field wipes (or baby wipes)
- □ (1) Large bottle of Body/Foot powder
- \Box (1) Sewing kit
- Females (1) pack of pads minimum. (No Tampons-Not Optional)

Seasonal Items - (1 Oct-15 Apr)

- □ (1) Gore-Tex bottom
- □ (1) Warming layer top
- □ (1) Warming layer bottom
- □ (1) Service issued sleeping system (complete)
- □ (1) Fleece Cap

Urban Training Gear:

- □ (3) Appropriate Civilian Attire (must have closed toed shoes, and shorts are not permitted)
- ☐ (1) Civilian Go-bag (Recommended, but not required. E.g., Jansport backpack, Northface, fanny packs, purses etc.)

Optional Items:

- □ Compass
- □ Bug repellent / uniform spray
- □ Toothbrush/Floss
- □ Chap stick (non-medicated)
- □ Snap link (subdued)
- □ Poly sleeping mat
- □ Sling rope
- □ Bungee cord(s)
- □ Petroleum jelly
- □ 3-Day assault pack

Prohibited Field Items:

- Cell phones or any portable electronic devices other than those issued by PR/SERE Staff
- Food, Supplements or energy drinks, gels or bars, snacks
- ☐ Medications not approved by MARSOC Medical personnel.
- Pyrotechnics, or Firearms
- Alcohol/Tobacco
- ☐ Jewelry (Rings, necklaces, bracelets)
- Contact Lenses
- D ID card, driver's license, credit card, money of any kind
- □ No machetes, swords, or axes
- No Handcuff Keys

STUDENTS WHO DO NOT HAVE THE REQUIRED GEAR WILL BE SUBJECT TO A SPOT REPORT. ACCUMULATION OF SPOT REPORTS CAN RESULT IN DISMISSAL FROM THE COURSE.
