MARSOF Master Assaulter Course (MMAC)

Individual Equipment List



The MMAC Instructor staff is very receptive and encourages students to experiment with different gear arrangements throughout the course; However, any gear used or arranged differently must always support safe training conditions.

Below is a list of rules regarding the individual equipment list.

1. Personally owned weapons and ammunition are not authorized.
2. Students who show up without the necessary equipment on the first day of training and cannot fix any major deficiencies by TD-2 will not participate.
3. Non-ANSI certified sunglasses are not authorized for use during this course.
4. Appropriate inclement weather gear can be worn/used; weather permitting.
5. Some field gear/uniforms used during field operations may not be appropriate for garrison classroom activities. Appropriate USMC uniform and civilian attire may be worn when not in a field environment. Issued Multi-Cam Crye Precision Uniforms are preferred. However, other patterns are acceptable if the student does not have Multi-Cam as long as it is flame retardant.
6. During this course, the student will be performing duties that he has not performed before and using equipment that he may not have used previously. The Crye Jumpable Plate Carrier (JPC) should be brought complete to the course, so the student has the gear available to reconfigure and adjust as needed.
7. Students should arrive with their plate carriers setup to facilitate stowing mechanical tools and shotgun.
8. Rifles, pistols, optics, NVGs, and radio(s) will be provided by MRTC for the students from units outside of the Camp Lejeune area. These students are encouraged to bring their issued weapons suite but are not required to do so.
9. Students must be prepared to stand overnight duties as the schedule requires. This may require additional equipment to deal with the elements.
