INTRODUCTION

The position is located in the Headquarters (HQ), Marine Forces Special Operations Command (MARSOC). MARSOC is one of several components of U.S. Special Operations Command (USSOCOM). The Commander, MARSOC is a U.S. Marine Corps Major General (0-8) and reports to the Commander, USSOCOM. In this capacity the Commander exercises command over a force of 3,300 active duty personnel from both the U.S. Marine Corps, U.S. Navy and U.S. Army in the conduct of Special Operations support of the Geographic Combatant Commanders (GCCs).

The UCXS (Requirements) Program falls under the staff cognizance of the AC/S G-8, MARSOC. The G-83 Current Requirements Branch is responsible for senior management and program analysis of classified and unclassified requirements, capability development, and for meeting materiel modernization requirements. The G8 Unmanned /Counter Unmanned Systems Program Manager (UCXSPM) serves as the UCXSPM for the Component, resides within the G-83, and as such oversees all aspects of requirements, administration, training, operations, and standardization of the MARSOC Unmanned Systems (UXS), Counter Unmanned Systems (CUSX), and Echelon 0 Precision Strike munitions programs.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT

This position is designated SPECIAL SENSITIVE and requires the employee to possess and maintain a TOP SECRET security clearance with access SENSITIVE COMPARTMENT INFORMATION (SCI). The employee may require access to Special Access Programs (SAP).

This position is a drug testing designated position under the DON Drug-Free Workplace Program.

Periodic travel is required (up to 20%). May be required to conduct TAD to assignments either CONUS or OCONUS to observe or support operations.

May be required to work other than normal duty hours, which may include evenings, weekends, and/or holidays.
